- · Rapid Renewals: Waiting for a response from Rapid Renewals.
- API: The Board voted unanimously to purchase the 3-year option of SOPHOS malware protection for the three office computers.
- Procurement Policy: Signed by Patricia.
- BRIC Grant: Katrina will call MDOT first thing 10/04 and request car counters. Linda will check in with Paul and follow up on the engineering report for Harold Ross Road and Dallas Hill Road. Paul has been out of town.
- Car counts taken from the Franklin County Sheriff's speed sign located in front of the Town Office on Dallas Hill Road from 4/13-4/27/2023 reviewed. 13,499 cars were counted during this time.
