## Town Meeting: Friday, June 14, 2024

To: T.A. Morgan, Resident of Dallas Plantation, in the County of Franklin, State of Maine

Greetings: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of Dallas Plantation, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Dallas Plantation Town House, on the 14<sup>th</sup> of June 2024 at six o'clock in the evening, to act on the following articles:

### Article 1:

To choose a moderator.

### Article 2:

To elect an Assessor for a three-year term, and for a one-year term.

### Article 3:

To elect a First Assessor, for a one-year term, from among the three elected Assessors.

### Article 4:

To elect one Budget Committee member for a two-year term. The Budget Committee consists of the Assessors and two elected members.

**Article 5:**

To see if the Plantation voters will authorize the Assessors to carry forward the balances in all Town Accounts.

**The Budget Committee recommends accepting as read.**

**Article 6:**

To see if the Plantation voters will authorize the Assessors to charge interest on overdue real estate taxes, 30 days after the due date that is printed on the tax bill.

**The Budget Committee recommends accepting as read.**

**Article 7:**

To see what rate of interest the Plantation will charge on overdue real estate taxes. (State statutory maximum: 8.5%)

**The Budget Committee recommends approving 8.5%.**

**Article 8:**

To see if the Plantation voters will authorize the Assessors to pay 4.0% interest on tax abatements and pay abatements from the overlay.

**The Budget Committee recommends accepting as read.**

## **Article 9:**

To see if the Plantation voters will authorize the Assessors to sell surplus personal property only if it has an estimated value less than \$10,000. Personal property over that amount shall be put out to bid.

**The Budget Committee recommends accepting as read.**

## **Article 10:**

To see if the Plantation voters will authorize the Assessors, on behalf of the Plantation, to sell and dispose of any real estate acquired for non-payment of taxes thereon, and to execute quit-claim deeds for said property. Said real estate to be sold as follows:

1. A notice of intent to sell such property shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Franklin County at least three weeks prior to such sale inviting interested parties to submit sealed bids thereon. The notice shall be inserted for five (5) consecutive days of publication; former owners to be notified by certified mail of the sale.
2. The Parties from whom the property has been taken, for non-payment of taxes therein, may purchase said real estate from the Plantation at any time before expiration of fourteen (14) days from the last date of publication. In the latter case, the purchase price shall consist of the following: back taxes, interest, and costs; cost of publication of notice, cost of quit-claim deed; any administrative and legal fees.
3. In the event the parties from whom the property has been taken by the Plantation for unpaid taxes fail to redeem the property, as provided in paragraph two (2), the Assessors may sell the property to the highest bidder. The Assessors have the authority to reject any, and all bids they deem too low.
4. In the event the property does not receive a bid or any or all bids are rejected, the Assessors may sell the property via the real estate market by listing the property with a broker of their choosing and set a purchase price reasonable for the current market. Except that the Municipal Officers shall use the special sale process required by 36 M.R.S. 943-C for qualifying homestead property if they choose to sell it to anyone other than the former owners.

**Article 11:**

To see if the Plantation voters will authorize the Assessors to apply for, accept, and expend without further action by Town Meeting, money from the State, Federal, or other government units or private sources, which becomes available during the year, pursuant to Title 30-A, Section 5682, of the Maine Revised Statutes, and to authorize the Assessors to accept on behalf of the Town, gifts, legacies, and devises made to the Town in trust for any public purpose. State and local funds include the following categories:

1. Local Roads Assistance Program (LRAP) – major road improvement funding
2. Maine DOT Road Assistance Programs
3. Municipal Revenue Sharing
4. Public Library State Aid per Capita
5. Snowmobile Registry Money
6. State Aid to Education
7. State Property Tax Relief Program
8. Tree Growth Reimbursement
9. Veterans Exemption Reimbursement
10. Tax Stabilization Reimbursement
11. Homestead Exemption Reimbursement
12. ARPA Funds
13. Solar Reimbursement
14. State grants or other funds, including private donations not included in items 1-13 above.
