

Dallas Plantation Assessors Meeting

Tuesday April 14, 2026

Acceptance of Minutes: LCaspar motioned to accept March 31st meeting minutes as written. Seconded by LJones, motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer:

- Bills reviewed and paid.

On-Going Business

Town House

- Maine Infrastructure Adaption Fund: KGacki and LJones provided an update on grant requirements and general information. Grant packet provided for review. Waiting on final plans to be completed by Acorn Engineering.
- A zoom meeting is scheduled with Christine Whelan, State Hazard Mitigation Officer with MEMA, to discuss BRIC Grant opportunity for shovel ready road projects on April 22nd at 1 PM.
- CEBE Municipal Resolution: document reviewed. LJones motioned to sign as written, seconded by LCaspar. Document signed by BOA.
- CEBE Self Evaluation and List of Community Actions: KGacki began draft work on each document. BOA will review and add content to be presented and discussed at the next BOA meeting.
- LCaspar completed a survey through the Real Estate Property Tax Relief Task Force for Dallas Plantation; noting increased financial assistance would make the most impact if applied to local education, county tax, and the Land Use Planning Commission.

Roads

- LJones has been in communication with seasonal plow driver DDuchesne and came up with a plan for end of season projects. Seasonal contract ends April 15th, and work completed after that date is paid on an hourly basis. LJones has shared the project list with LCaspar and KGacki via email.

Other:

- KGacki brought up Animal Control Officer, Ryan Thompson's mandated training and explained that while he serves 5 communities each municipality has different terms for employment. Dallas and Rangeley Plantation are believed to be the only ones who pay an hourly wage for training. Ryan has 4 hours of

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training scheduled. BOA unanimously agreed to pay him for 2 of those 4 hours at his hourly rate.

- KGacki spoke with Sandy River Plantation Clerk, Ethna Thompson who scheduled Ryan's training through their office, during the conversation the lack of a local kennel for dogs was brought up. This was discussed and the BOA requested this be on the agenda for the next Regional Meeting.
- KGacki inquired if the BOA would be amendable to KGacki working the School Budget Meeting from 5:30 to 6 PM to check-in registered voters, and leave when the meeting begins so husband, Daniel Gacki can do his part as a school board member; the swap being due to our young kids. KGacki asked EThompson, Sandy River Plantation Clerk, if she would check-in any Dallas Plantation voters after I leave, and she agreed to help. BOA unanimously approved plan.
