

“Municipal Resolution: Emergency Medical Services Transport Plan for Dallas Plantation, Maine”

Authority

This regulatory ordinance is adopted pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. Section 3172; requiring municipal officers of each municipality to adopt a plan stipulating the method by which transporting emergency medical services will be delivered within the municipality.

Purpose

Dallas Plantation is committed to ensuring clear, reliable emergency medical pathways for all residents and visitors in emergency situation.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the municipal officers of Dallas Plantation, Maine that the following Emergency Medical Services Transport Plan is hereby adopted:

Primary Provider

Transporting emergency medical services within the borders of Dallas Plantation shall be primarily provided by Maine Health EMS.

Service Model

Model B: Contracted EMS Coverage service will be provided under a formal contract/agreement with Maine Health EMS.

Public Posting

The resolution shall be posted publicly at the Dallas Plantation Office and on the plantation’s website in the same manner as municipal ordinances.

Amendments

This plan may be amended by the Municipal Officers as necessary. Any amended plan shall be submitted to Maine EMS within thirty (30) days of adoption.

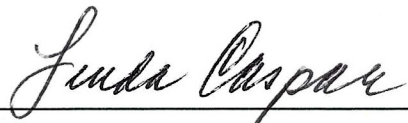
Effective Date

This ordinance was adopted by a majority of the Municipal Officers effective date August 4, 2026.

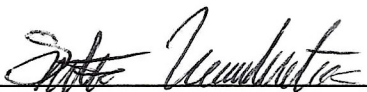

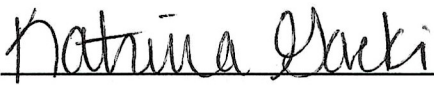
